this commentary on the letter of jude engages the greek text and is designed for pastors theological students and lay readers jude a brother of jesus warns members of the early jesus movement against intruders in their midst and exhorts those believers not to deviate from the fundamental tenets of the faith in behavior and belief it also provides a unique analysis that links jude with 1 corinthians in terms of their authors literary style jewish backgrounds and closely correlated descriptions of the errorists described in both letters the letter of jude is highly relevant to christians in the twenty first century even many of those now calling themselves evangelical have abandoned any pretence to adhering to biblical doctrines this commentary seeks to emphasise jude message contend for biblical truth and live so that the gospel of our lord jesus christ is alive true and liberating

the epistle of jude is often overlooked because it is one of the shortest books in the bible yet its author a half brother of jesus christ manages in a mere 25 verses to encapsulate one of the major themes of the entire bible the danger of apostasy jude sounds a warning against falling away from god whether through unbelief pride or sheer complacency in jude s day the immediate danger was from false teachers who had crept into the church bringing heretical doctrine for their own personal gain at the expense of other people s souls this same danger exists in every generation of the church and it certainly exists today pastor melissa scott unfolds the scriptures through use of the best extant manuscripts along with in depth word studies

and ancient extra biblical writings she explains how jude s readers would have understood his writing in their day and how we can apply jude s teachings to our relationship with jesus christ the epistle of jude a clarion call to contend for the faith proves how one of the shortest books in the bible is one of the most useful for the church today

presented here in paperback for the first time is john peter lange s theologischhomiletisches bibelwerk intended to help preachers prepare sermons the commentary series is essentially biblical and evangelical catholic this nineteenth century commentary has served as a standard reference for more than a century many early reviewers regarded schaff s edition with his additional material as superior to the original it has proven to be a complete and useful commentary and continues to prove especially valuable to ministers it contains critical annotations of the text and its translation and a threefold commentary exegetical doctrinal and homiletical under these three heads the text is viewed from every aspect

this work provides in english translation what survives of commentary upon the epistle of jude from the first millennium of the christian church five texts feature the relevant portion of clement of alexandria s hypotyposes and the commentaries of didymus the blind of alexandria pseudo oecumenius and the venerable bede with these is included the scholia extracts from other no longer extant works published by dean cramer in his catena of the greek fathers on jude each translated text is provided with notes the book is prefaced with two chapters which place these commentators in their historical context and compare their handling of the material

this is part of a series of modern commentaries based on new english translations made by their respective editors while adhering strictly to sound scholarship and doctrine they intend above all to bring out the theological and religious message of the new testament to the contemporary church

this keepsake hard cover edition of the epistle of jude was taken from the king james translation of the bible the king james translation is a masterwork of style and the most important book in the english language it has been the driving force in shaping the english speaking world for hundreds of years jude urges his readers to defend the deposit of christ s doctrine that had been closed by the time he wrote his epistle and to remember the words of the apostles spoken somewhat before jude then asks the reader to recall how even after the lord saved his own people out of the land of egypt he did not hesitate to destroy those who fell into unbelief much as he punished the angels who fell from their original exalted status and sodom and gomorrah jude is one of the shortest books in the bible and is sold at or near the publisher s cost and offered up for the collector who wished to have an unbroken set of this keepsake editions

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
